

The RACERS Code of Conduct (RACERS CoC)

Code of Conduct Mission Statement

To create & maintain an environment which ensures the safety, enjoyment and viability of competitive and recreational motorsport activities for the benefit of all the Key Stakeholders.

In this context the Key Stakeholders are the:

- Participants in an activity
- Managers and committees of the Event Provider
- Officials and service providers assisting in the delivery of an activity.

Purpose of this document

It is important to state up front that this document <u>does not</u> contain or cover technical requirements, or sporting regulations. The responsibility for setting and enforcing these types of regulations resides with the Event Providers (EPs) that are promoting and delivering the activities.

It defines the behaviour that is expected from Participants. It does this by clearly listing the Transgressions, the Endangerment levels within a particular Transgression and how it is established. There is a table of Demerit points to be applied for a particular circumstance given the Endangerment Level and the Transgression.

This document consists of four main parts.

- 1. This explanatory pre-amble of the underlying principles and the behaviour RACERS requires from Participants in its events.
- 2. A Description Matrix which defines the Transgressions and Endangerment Levels of the incident or behaviour.
- 3. The Demerit Points Matrix which defines points that are assigned to the combination of those factors, listed are the minimum points that can be applied, and multiple transgressions are cumulative.
- 4. The Penalty Matrix which sets out the penalty to be served by the Participant for the number of Demerit Points incurred and the period those points are to be applied for.

Underlying Principle:

Egalitarian by nature - no monetary fines – care & well being of others is paramount.

The Event Provider is responsible for:

- The provision and training of Officials to implement, police & enforce the RACERS CoC for all activities within the Event Description.
- Provide the Technical Officers to ensure the compliance of Vehicles to their regulations.
- Provide a Driving Standards Observer to ensure participant behaviour meets the requirements of the RACERS CoC and implement a system to guarantee the enforcement of penalties allocated by the DSO during the Event.
- Ensure that Participants are correctly Licenced to participate in an event.
- Implement a system to enforce of penalties allocated by the DSO during the Event.
- Advise RACERS the name of the Participant(s), the DEMERIT POINTS allocated and their validity period of the points via the End Of Day Report..
- Ensuring the Participants understand the RACERS CoC and agree to abide by them.
- Specifically referring Participants to the RACERS CoC in their entry forms & conditions.
- The EP has the right to refuse an entry, if an entry is refused the entry fee is to be refunded in full.
- Mandate the Safety Check Lists be completed by the PAXs of participating vehicles.
